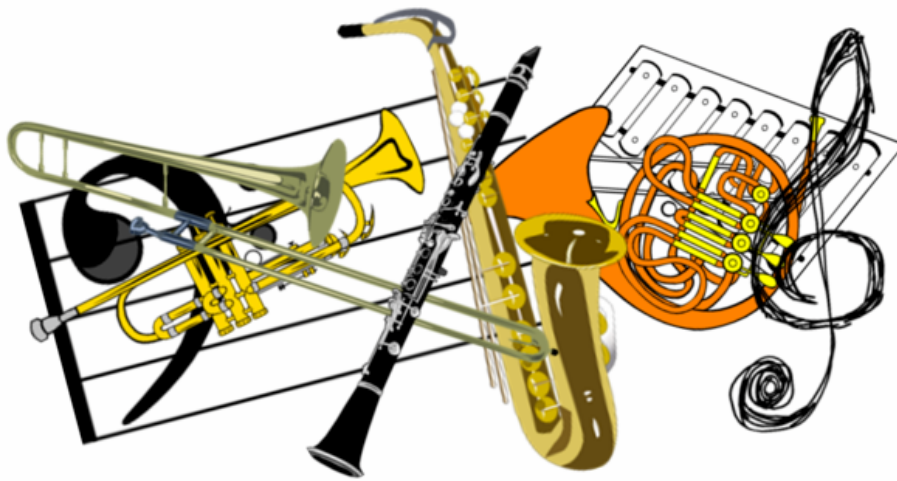

Dr. Lynn Wayne Seipp is a professional musician and educator, who lives in Lynchburg Virginia. He is a recitalist/soloist on the clarinet and saxophone and was the principal clarinet in the Lynchburg Symphony Orchestra from 1986-2016. Dr. Seipp has studied with several notable clarinet artists including Harold Wright (Boston Symphony), Larry Combs (Chicago Symphony), Charles Krusenstjerna (West Virginia University/Eastman), and Harry Schmidt (Miami Symphony / Florida State University). He holds the B.F.A., M.M. and D.M. Degrees and has taught college level classes at West Virginia University and Florida State University (Instructor, part-time), Union University (Tennessee) and Liberty University (Virginia). From 1985-2009, he was employed full-time at Liberty University in the Dept. of Music and Humanities and served in the following roles: Associate Professor, Instrumental Coordinator, Director of the Liberty University Orchestra, Woodwind Instructor and a teacher of numerous music and humanities courses. In 2001, he was the featured soloist in Copland's *Concerto for Clarinet and Orchestra* with the Lynchburg Symphony Orchestra. This performance was later broadcast on WVTR Radio. On March 27th, 1999, Dr. Seipp performed *Uncertainty Principle* (for Clarinet and Piano), the winner of the College Music Society's 1999 composition prize, at the College Music Society's Mid Atlantic Convention at Sweet Briar College. In 1994, he successfully presented a solo clarinet performance at the University of Oklahoma's Clarinet Symposium. From 1966-69, SSG E6 Seipp (USA) was a Staff Clarinet/Saxophone Instructor at the Armed Forces School of Music (formerly the Navy School of Music) located at Norfolk, Virginia.

Dr. Lynn Wayne Seipp has been a resident of Lynchburg since 1985, and he and his wife, Sonna, have two children, Lisa and Larry; who have their own families and are living in the Lynchburg area.





Trumpeter **Chuck Seipp** retired from The United States Army Band, “Pershing’s Own,” culminating his 32-year career as Concert Band Group Leader. Sergeant Major Seipp performed at national, presidential and historical world events, at concerts and special events in Washington, D.C., and for funerals and wreath-laying ceremonies at the Tomb of The Unknown Soldier in Arlington National Cemetery. He performed with the Concert Band, Orchestra, Ceremonial Band, Herald Trumpets, Brass Quintet, and was a featured soloist.

Chuck has toured and recorded solo trumpet and organ repertoire throughout Europe with world-renowned organist Diane Bish, appearing regularly on her “Joy of Music” television series. In addition, he has performed with The U.S. Army Brass Quintet. As an active teacher, soloist, clinician and performer, he has performed locally with the National Symphony Orchestra, Washington Opera House Orchestra, Washington Ballet Orchestra, and Washington Bach Consort. He also leads and is active throughout the Mid-Atlantic Region with The Commonwealth Brass Quintet. Chuck enjoys his travels across the country with Arlington National Cemetery Ceremonial Organist, Dr. Randall Sheets, as the Seipp/Sheets Duo.

Through CJ Seipp Music Publications, he markets his own brass arrangements, many of which have been played and recorded by the Canadian Brass Quintet, The U.S. Army Brass Quintet and many groups around the world. Chuck’s recording project of The Wedding Book is a collection of his own arrangements and has proven to be a valuable resource for organists and trumpet players.

He served on faculty as adjunct professor of trumpet at Shenandoah University in Winchester, Virginia, from 2013 to 2019 and previously served as visiting professor of trumpet at Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas, from 2012 to 2013.

Chuck, Yamaha Performing Artist, holds an undergraduate music education degree from The University of Kansas and masters and doctoral degrees in trumpet performance from The Catholic University of America. Chuck is leader of the Commonwealth Brass Quintet and a Yamaha Performing Artist.

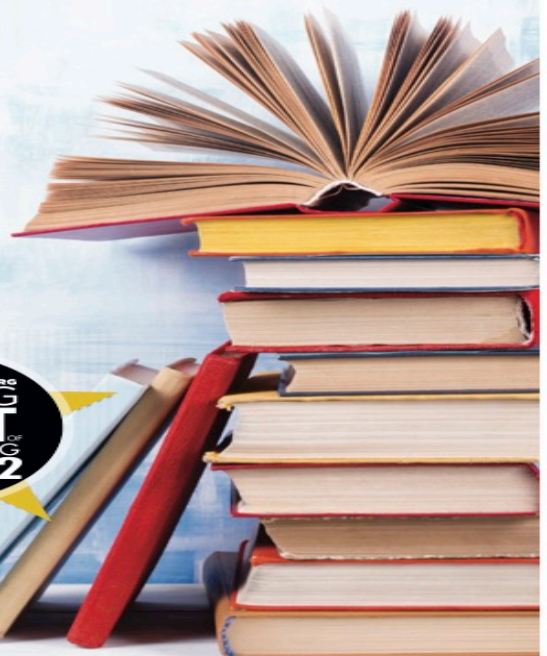

**Jim Meredith** has been a fixture in Lynchburg's music scene since 1974. From 1974-2013 he taught middle school band at Dunbar Middle School and Sandusky Middle School. The bands at these schools received consistent superior ratings at Virginia Band Assessments and competed in concert band competitions, often taking home 1<sup>st</sup> Place while competing with high school bands. In 1990 the Sandusky Advanced Band was one of 3 middle school bands selected world wide to present a concert at the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago Illinois. In 2007 the band won the NAI National Middle School Band Competition in Charlotte, North Carolina. As a composer Jim's music (under the name Meredith) is played by middle school, high school, and community bands and orchestras all over the United States. In 2010 Jim received the VBODA Music Educator of the Year. In 2012 he was one of 8 band directors chosen nationwide to receive the prestigious John Philip Sousa/ Bandworld Magazine Legion Laureate Award. In 2014 his alma mater, the Shenandoah Conservatory of Music bestowed upon him the Distinguished Alumni Lifetime Achievement Award. In November of 2021 he was inducted into the VBODA Band Director's Hall of Fame. Jim believes wholeheartedly in Psalm 37:4 "Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart." Jim is happily married to his wife Kathy (41 years), and devoted to his daughter, Laura, son Michael, and three beautiful granddaughters.
